### Sub: Directions under section 5 of The Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986

Whereas, Central Pollution Control Board is the State Board for all the Union Territories to exercise powers and performs functions under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

And whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has delegated all its powers and functions under Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 in respect of NCT of Delhi to Delhi Pollution Control Committee vide Notification No. S.O. 198(E) dated 15.03.1991.


And whereas, CPCB in exercise of powers vested under section 5 of The Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 and in view of anticipated deterioration in Delhi air quality has directed to ensure following,

1. Strict enforcement of preventive, punitive and mitigative action in identified traffic corridors.
2. Strict vigilance and action including issuing challan to visibly polluting and overloaded vehicles.
3. Random auditing of pollution under control (PUC) certification centers before onset of winter season.
4. Implementing effective parking plan and action against unauthorized parking of vehicles especially in congested areas.
5. Non compliance to above directions shall be dealt strictly as per regulatory provisions including prosecution and levying hefty penalty.
6. Rigorous follow up and swift action on complaints forwarded through SAMEER app and Social Media accounts (Facebook & Twitter), preferably within 24 hours.

Now, therefore, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers conferred under section 5 of The Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, and keeping in view to curb high air pollution in Delhi, DPCC hereby directs Delhi Police, DMRC, Department of Transport and Local Bodies to take necessary steps to comply with the above directions.

In case of non-compliance, action as per the provisions contained in Section 15 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be initiated against the defaulters.
