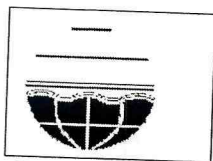

Sub: Directions under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, as amended to date read along with Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016; the Standard Operating Procedure and Checklist of Minimal Requisite Facilities for utilization of hazardous waste under Rule 9 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary movement) Rules, 2016 (specifically w.r.t. utilization of Spent Fixer (Hypo) solution Generated From Photographic / X-Ray Films) in October, 2016 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended to date

Whereas, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India has notified the **Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016** in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 8 and 25 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986).

And whereas, Central Pollution Control Board has published Standard Operating Procedure and Checklist of Minimal Requisite Facilities for utilization of hazardous waste under Rule 9 of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary movement) Rules, 2016 specifically w.r.t. Utilization of Spent Fixer (Hypo) solution Generated From Photographic / X-Ray Films in October, 2016.

And whereas, as per the provisions of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, no unit can operate without the consent of the concerned State Pollution Control Board in an air pollution area.

And whereas, as per provisions of the **Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016** read along with Standard Operating Procedure and Checklist of Minimal Requisite Facilities for utilization of hazardous waste under Rule 9, as mentioned above, any person/ unit involved in the utilization of Spent Fixer (Hypo) solution generated from Photographic / X-Ray Films is required to obtain authorization and consent(s) from the concerned State Pollution Control Board(s).

And whereas, in response to a letter dated 29/05/2018 from Delhi Pollution Control Committee, the name of your unit **M/s V. K. Plastic Enterprises, 96/6, Ist Floor, Arya Nagar Indl. Area, Ghaziabad, U.P.- 201102** (hereinafter referred as "Addressee") was forwarded by Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred as UPPCB) as the unit authorized under Hazardous Waste Rules 2016 for recycling/ utilization of X-ray fixer solution.

And whereas, the name of Addressee was forwarded by Delhi Pollution Control Committee to all the Health Care Establishments operating in NCT of Delhi vide Circular dated 10.07.2018 for disposal of X-ray Fixer Solution and Developer. It was done as a suggestion as per the decision taken by the Advisory Committee without any embargo for the Health Care Establishments to dispose their waste through other registered recycler(s) having valid Authorization and Consent to Operate.

And whereas, the circular issued was purely on the basis of authorization and consent issued by UPPCB to the addressee.

And whereas, complaints has been received consistently against the addressee regarding illegal disposal / selling of Hazardous waste i.e. X-ray Hypo Fixer Solution.

And whereas, UPPCB vide order dated 05/02/19 has revoked the consent issued to the addressee under section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended to date.

And whereas, UPPCB vide order dated 22/02/19 has directed the unit, under section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, to not to resume its operations without taking consent from UPPCB.

And whereas, in the above mentioned directions issued by UPPCB on 22/02/19, the Board has mentioned that during the inspection on 25/01/2018 and 12/02/19 the unit was found totally closed.

Now therefore, in view of the above, the Competent Authority in Delhi Pollution Control Committee, in exercise of powers conferred upon it under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 amended to date directs the Addressee (**M/s V. K. Plastic Enterprises, 96/6, 1st Floor, Arya Nagar Industrial Area, Ghaziabad, U.P.- 201102**) to not to collect X-ray Fixer Solution and Developer from any of the HCFs of NCT of Delhi from now onwards. Also the circular dated 10.07.2018 issued earlier is hereby revoked with immediate effect.

This issue with the approval of the Chairman, DPCC.
