Sub: Minutes of 2nd and 3rd meeting of Expert Committee constituted for evaluation and recommendation of projects for utilization of Environmental Compensation funds in DPCC held on 25.01.2021 and 27.01.2021.

2nd and 3rd meeting of the Expert Committee constituted for evaluation and recommendation of projects for utilization of Environmental Compensation funds in DPCC was held under the chairmanship of Member Secretary, DPCC in the Conference Hall at ISBT Kashmere Gate on 25.01.2021 and 27.01.2021.

Following officers were present:

Following decisions were taken in the meetings:

1. Upgradation of DPCC Lab: Development of facility for analysis of hazardous waste sample.

The revised proposal submitted by DPCC Lab has been considered and the committee recommended the proposal for approval for an amount of Rs. 5,69,00000 (Rs. Five Crore Sixty Nine Lakhs). The project is proposed to be completed by 31.03.2022. (Action by DPCC Lab).

2. Continuous Water Quality Monitoring of Yamuna River in Delhi.

The revised proposal submitted by DPCC Lab has been considered and the committee recommended the proposal for approval for an amount of

Rs. 17,00,00,000 (Rs. Seventeen Crore) including consultancy charges. The project is proposed to be completed by 31.03.2022. (Action by DPCC Lab)

3. Assessment and Remediation of Contaminated Sites.

The project proposal shall be submitted after identification and assessment of the gravity of the contamination of the sites by third party. (Action by CMC-I)

4. Research and Development issues for Prevention and Control of Pollution as per CPCB letter dated 26.11.2020s."


In addition to the four issues identified for Research and Development on previous meeting, following three more issues to be incorporated while sending a communication to CPCB:

- 1) Bio-remediation Techniques for Polluted surface water bodies.
- 2) Impact of Aviation fuel on Ambient Air Quality in landing and take of funnel.
- 3) Water Hyacinth management in Yamuna and Drains.

It was further decided that DPCC Lab shall prepare long term action plan for upgradation of Air and Water Lab keeping in view of at least for 10 years.

Next meeting of the Expert Committee is fixed for 02.02.2021.
