

Minutes of the 33<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Committee for II(b) Category Cases  
held on 22.02.2021

Attendance Sheet for meeting on 22.02.2021 is enclosed as Annexure - A.

Following are the minutes of the meeting along with the decisions taken:-

**Agenda Item No 1: All Complete pending cases from 03.11.2018 to 17.02.2021**

The cases of this agenda were decided online. If any Consent to Establish / Consent to Operate application (s) (for the activity generating hazardous waste / generating trade effluent discharge) has been granted by the Committee inadvertently, the said decision is reviewed and the consent application shall be kept in abeyance till the comprehensive opinion from Senior Counsel of DPCC is received.

During the meeting, the following decisions were also taken in the meeting:-

- (i) It was apprised to the Committee, the opinions of two advocates have been taken in view of the order of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal dated 20.03.2020 in O.A. No. 159/2013 in the matter of All India Lokadhikar Sangathan Vs. GNCTD, in respect of Stainless Steel Pickling units i.e. ***"Till establishment of TSDF and up-gradation of CETP no new industry be permitted in the industrial areas"***.

After detailed discussions, it was observed that the said opinions are not clear in respect of incinerable / recyclable hazardous waste generation, therefore, it was decided to take a fresh self-speaking opinion from Sh. Sanjeev Ralli / Sh. N.P. Singh, Advocate on the above said issue on priority and the same will be discussed in the next II(b) meeting.

- (ii) The issue of Ready Mix Concrete (RMCs) Plants was discussed w.r.t. the jurisdiction to deal with the consent applications being received from these plants. After detailed discussions, it was decided that the CMCs will deal with the consent applications

filed by the stand alone plants. EIA Cell shall continue to deal with the applications for the RMCs installed exclusively for Environmental Clearance (EC) project within the boundaries of projects / adjacent plots of EC project in which Environmental Clearances has been obtained if consent for RMC is also applied separately. CMCs shall handle and process the applications based on their area jurisdiction.


- (iii) As per DPCC categorization, the activity "Ayurvedic and Homeopathic Medicines" covers under hazardous waste generating activity however there is a possibility that no hazardous waste is generated from such type of activities. Committee decided to place the said activity before the categorization committee to reconsider the categorization of the said activity w.r.t. generation / non generation of hazardous waste.
- (iv) An inspection of the hazardous waste generating unit(s) is not conducting in time bound manner due to which decision of such applications are pending. Therefore, committee decided to grant Consent to Operate (Renewal) to the units those are generating incinerable/recyclable hazardous waste with the condition that unit shall make an agreement with the authorized operators for collecting / disposal of incinerable/recyclable hazardous waste. Subsequently, inspection be conducted. Authorization under HWM Rules be kept in abeyance in view of directions of CPCB in certain types of wastes generated.
- (v) During the meeting, it was decided to issue registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 after issuance of Consent to Operate/Consent to Operate (Renewal) if the documents are found in order.
- (vi) It is learnt that inspite of decisions taken in the meeting, all the decided cases remains pending. Chairman of the Committee has directed all CMCs engineers to implement the decisions of the Committee w.r.t. grant of consent without waiting for the minutes and the same will be issued within 03 days.


- (vii) It was observed that in most of the cases, checklist was not prepared properly and concerned Cell did not provide its recommendations. Chairman of the Committee directed that the concerned Cell will prepare checklist and give proper recommendations.
- (viii) It was apprised to the Committee that during the implementation of the decisions of the Committee w.r.t issuance of consent, it was observed that the submitted documents are not found in order, therefore, clarifications / SCNs were issued online to the unit seeking requisite documents. In spite of issuance of 2-3 clarifications / SCNs, unit has not uploaded the requisite documents. Committee decided to refuse all such applications and issue Show Cause Notice u/s 33(A) of Water Act and u/s 31(A) of Air Act for operating without consent from DPCC.
- (ix) All CMCs are directed to check each and every documents including required consent fee before issuing the consent to establish and consent to operate.

All the decisions taken in the meeting shall be implemented without waiting for the minutes.


The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.


