

Response to the queries received on DPCC's EOI dated 22 March 2021 for setting up 2 CBWTFs in Delhi

1(a)	<p>With respect to the sub clause 4 of clause no 3 i.e. Scope of Work of Eol</p> <p>It is submitted that the land be provided by Delhi Government or Municipal Corporation as per BMW Rules 2016.</p> <p>Existing Municipal Corporation can allow usage of their existing dumping Ground or Processing and Disposal Plant to be used (in part for CBWTFs) . This may kindly be permitted</p>	No change.
1(b)	<p>With respect to the clause 6 of clause no 4 i.e. Minimum Eligibility Criteria of Eol</p> <p>Getting both Owned lands or getting the land lease registered to be meet the eligibility criteria would be difficult for most of the bidders within this short period of time. Moreover, such conditions seem to fit only a selected set of bidders which is not a healthy completion. In view of the above it is requested that DPCC may remove or amend this clause to allow the selected bidder to get the ownership of land through purchase or through registered lease deed before the date of receipt of CTO.</p>	No change.
1(c)	<p>As per sub clause 13 of clause no 4 i.e. Minimum Eligibility Criteria:</p> <p>We request DPCC to specify the present location of the present CBWTF in Delhi.</p>	Present location means the location where operational CBWTF is currently in operation.
1(d)	<p>With respect to the sub clause 9 of clause no 4 i.e. Minimum Eligibility Criteria of Eol</p> <p>As it is not clear as to what the estimated project value is as per DPCC, we request DPCC to clarify the same.</p> <p>Further we request DPCC to consider reducing the BG value to be 1 % of the estimated project value</p>	<p>Estimated cost of the project shall be addressed in the RFP stage.</p> <p>Eolders who have not provided the proof of possession of land (ownership/ registered lease) and qualify for RFP stage, will be required to submit Bank Guarantee of 10% of the estimated project value, as decided by DPCC, valid for 90 days from date of RFP, along with the submission of RFP.</p>
1(e)	<p>With respect to the sub clause no 7 & 8 of clause no 6 i.e. Evaluation Criteria of Eol Getting both Owned lands Or getting the land lease registered to be meet the eligibility criteria would be difficult for most of the bidders within this short period of time.</p> <p>Moreover such conditions seem to fit only a selected set of bidders which is not a healthy completion. In view of the above it is requested that DPCC may remove or amend this clause to allow the selected bidder to get the ownership of land through purchase or through registered lease deed before the date of receipt of CTO.</p>	No change.

1(f)	<p>With respect to the clause no 1 para 3 states that “In order to estimate the future generation of biomedical waste, the detailed primary and secondary data analysis have been undertaken, Specific Waste Generation Factors (SWGf) were evolved.”</p> <p>To the best our knowledge, we have not come across the terminology of SWGF in guideline by any pollution control board. Hence we request DPCC to kindly share the formula for Specific Waste Generation Factors (SWGf) and also the detailed calculation for deriving 80 T/day</p>	<p>The quantity of 80TPD is tentative estimate and the proponents who submit EOIs are free; before submitting their EOIs, to make their own estimates/ judgments about above mentioned figures/ related factors /numbers of HCFs/ waste generation and their rate(s) of variations/increments during the existing or operative period of proposed CBWTFs. The proponent(s) cannot make any claim about the veracity of the earlier provided data either before/during/after submission of their EOIs and/or Detailed Proposals later and/or during establishment and/or scheduled operational period of proposed CBWTF(s).</p>
1(g)	<p>With respect to the clause 1 of the Note of clause no 6 of Evaluation Criteria of Eligible Eolders states that: The service of collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of BMW to the Delhi Government health care facilities shall be provided free of cost by the selected Eolders.</p> <p>May this point be removed to ensure the viability of the project as Government of NCT of Delhi is not providing any land for the project.</p> <p>Further by making the services free to HCF of Delhi government, the occupier of the waste will not discharge his duties of segregation whereby it would amount to violation of Schedule I of BMW Rules 2016 and Polluters pay principle</p>	<p>No change.</p> <p>As per Prevailing Directorate Of Health Services, Govt. Of NCT of Delhi rates, services to Delhi Govt. HCFs is being provided free of cost by currently operational CBWTFs.</p>
1(h)	<p>We request DPCC to kindly provide the details of facilitations/assistance that DPCC or Government of Delhi shall be providing to EOI holders for this project.</p>	<p>Refer EOI document for details.</p>
1(i)	<p>As the EOI holder is to make the entire investment, we request DPCC/Delhi Government to provide capital Grants for this project to ensure viability of the project.</p>	<p>No such Capital Grant proposed.</p>
1(j)	<p>As the project is to be executed by selected bidder on behalf of Government of Delhi, we request DPCC/Delhi Government to arrange to get the Environment Clearance for this project to avoid any uncertainty to the bidder in the event of rejection of EC by SEIAA or MoEF&CC</p>	<p>No change.</p> <p>Please refer scope of work in EOI document.</p>
2(a)	<p>With respect to the point no. 3 (4) of Scope of work of Eoi The Eolder should come up with requisite land of minimum 0.5 acre in an approved industrial area of Delhi.</p> <p>The acute shortage of approved industrial land at Delhi the notified industrial area should also be allowed</p>	<p>No change.</p>

2(b)	<p>With respect to the point no 4 (7) of Minimum Eligibility criteria of EoI</p> <p>The Eolder should have the land of 0.5 Acre or more (either Owned / Registered Lease) for setting up of a CBWTF in at Approved Industrial area / Notified Industrial Area.</p> <p>It should be only Lease agreement instead of Registered lease as it involves cost before awarding the contract</p>	No change.
2(c)	<p>To provide free of cost services to Delhi Govt. HCFs, we need to have the information of number of units, including number of beds at HCF to ascertain the cost involved for providing the services to the same.</p>	<p>Delhi Govt. HCFs being catered by existing CBWTF are :</p> <p>Region 1: Dispensaries: 71 DHS Hospital: 9 (~3830 beds) Mohalla clinic: 59</p> <p>Region 2: Dispensaries: 97 DHS Hospital: 19 (~5698) Mohalla clinic:114</p>
