Sub: Recruitment of Group-'A' Posts in Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC)

The Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) is a self-sustained autonomous body working under the administrative control of Environment Department, Govt. of NCT Delhi and exercises the delegated powers and functions of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) under section 4(4) of the Water Act, 1974 and section 6 of the Air Act, 1981. DPCC entrusted with the responsibility to regulate the industries and commercial establishments in Delhi as per the provisions of Air Act, 1981 and Water Act, 1974. DPCC act as a regulatory body for implementation of various Pollution Control Act Rules, Notifications, and Court orders in NCT of Delhi. DPCC does not receive any Grant in Aid from the Govt. of NCT of Delhi / Govt. of India for meeting its expenses.

DPCC is following the Pay & Allowance and other employee's benefits as per the 7th CPC and Orders/Guidelines issued by Govt. of NCT of Delhi and DOPT from time to time.

The DPCC intends to fill up the vacant Group 'A' posts of 'Assistant Environmental Engineer' (AEE) in Level-10 (PB:3 Rs 56100-177500) on regular basis against the promotion failing which by direct recruitment quota in accordance with RRs of the post of AEE as available on DPCC website. The reservations of posts for SCs/STs & OBCs etc., is applicable as per the orders /guidelines issued by GNCTD and Govt. of India. The tentative details of various categories of posts are as under:

Reservation under OBC Category will be provided only to those candidates who submit OBC certificates issued by Govt. of NCT of Delhi. Candidates who submit OBC certificate issued by other States/UTs will be considered as General/Unreserved candidates against General. Further, the communities of OBC as per Delhi Government

will be considered for OBC reservation even though in UPSC ESE exam, it was considered as General under Central list.

For candidates for OBC/EWS category, the certificate must be issued by the Competent Authority and must have been issued on or before the submission of application by the candidate.

In case of EWS, the appointment will be provisional and is subject to the Income and Asset Certificate being verified through the proper channel and if the verification reveals that claim to belong of EWS is fake/false the services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any reasons and without prejudice to such further action as may be taken under the provision of Indian Penal Code for production of Fake/False certificate.

The Merit List of 'Non-Recommended Candidates of Engineering Service Examination (ESE), 2023' as available on the UPSC website is being utilized for recruitment of above Group 'A' posts of AEEs.

In case, if you are interested to join DPCC as AEE, it is requested to provide the updated Resume/CV in the prescribed format as available on DPCC website within 30 days from the date of issue of this letter. No late receipt of the application/letter, whatever reasons, will be entertained by the DPCC. This communication in no manner will confer any right to the job in DPCC.
