ADDENDUM

Subject: - Directions under section 31(A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 read with rule 20A (6) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) (Union Territories) Rules, Act 1983, read with direction of Environment Pollution (Prevention & Control) Authority (EPCA) dated 20/1/2017.

Whereas, in view of the severe ambient air pollution levels in Delhi, directions were issued to Badarpur Thermal Power Plant u/s 31(A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 read with rule 20A(6) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) (Union Territories) Rules 1983, vide letter of even number dated 6/11/2016 for:-

1. Closure of all the units with immediate effect from 07.11.2016 to 16.11.2016.
2. No lifting of fly ash from fly ash storage area, for any purpose, from 07.11.2016 to 16.11.2016.
3. Ensuring regular sprinkling of water in fly ash storage area.

And whereas, vide order dated 16-11-2016 the above said directions were extended upto 31-01-2017.

And whereas, Graded Response Action Plan was discussed in the meeting of 20th January 2017 of EPCA.

And whereas, EPCA directed Govt. of Delhi "Based on current air quality levels as monitored by CPCB, the Graded Plan would be enforced in the "Moderate to Poor" category in all district of NCR. In Delhi, where the air pollution levels have been either "Very Poor or Severe", the Graded Response Plan would be Severe category in force."

And whereas, *implementation of Graded Response Action Plan in the category of "Very Poor and Severe" includes Closure of Badarpur Thermal Power Plant.*

And whereas, Very Poor Ambient Air Quality still exists in Delhi, as per the data monitored by CPCB.

Now therefore, in continuation of orders issued on 6-11-2016 & 16-11-2016 and in view of the above facts, all units of Badarpur Thermal Power Plant will remain closed till further orders.
