Sub: Directions under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, as amended to date.

Whereas, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India has notified the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, in supersession of earlier Bio-Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998, for the proper management of the Bio Medical Waste.

And whereas, as per the provisions of the said Rules, every transporter/ Institution / unit generating / transporting Bio Medical including Hazardous Waste, requires proper disposal of bio-medical waste. It is also the duty of the transporter/ Institution / unit generating / transporting to take all steps to ensure that Bio Medical Waste/ Hazardous Waste is handled without any adverse effect to human health and the environment.

And whereas, the name of your unit, **M/s Malana Silver Nitrate Recycling Unit, Village Rampura Gujran, Tehsil Moonak, Distt. Sangrur, Punjab-148033** (hereinafter referred as "Addressee") was forwarded to all the Health Care Establishments vide Circular dated 08.8.2018 for the disposal of X-ray Fixer Solution and Developer as a suggestion as per the decision taken by the Advisory Committee without any embargo for the Health Care Establishments to dispose their waste through other registered recycler(s) having valid Authorization and Consent to Operate.

And whereas, complaint has been received against the addressee regarding illegal disposal / selling of Hazardous waste X-ray Hypo Fixer Solution through the Office of Hon'ble Minister for Food & Civil Supplies, Environment & Forests and Elections, Govt of NCT of Delhi vide letter dated 13.9.2018.


And whereas, a show cause notice was issued to the Addressee vide letter dated 01.10.2018 seeking all credible documents such as details of vehicles deployed for the transportation, toll receipts, GPS records of the vehicles and other statutory requirements

for the disposal of Hazardous Waste for collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of X-ray Fixer Solution and Developer collected from the HCFs of NCT of Delhi within 7 days of receipt of the said SCN.

And whereas, no reply has been received from the Addressee in response to the above said SCN.

Now therefore, in view of the above, the Competent Authority in Delhi Pollution Control Committee, in exercise of powers conferred upon it under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 amended to date directs the Addressee (**M/s Malana Silver Nitrate Recycling Unit, Village Rampura Gujran, Tehsil Moonak,, Distt. Sangrur, Punjab -148033**) to not to collect X-ray Fixer Solution and Developer from any of the HCFs of NCT of Delhi from now onwards. Also the circular dated 08.08.2018 issued earlier is hereby revoked with immediate effect.

This issue with the approval of the Member Secretary, DPCC.
