Office Order

Consequent upon the decision of 67th DPCC Board meeting held on 25th October 2018, the following policy shall be followed henceforth with regard to the Hospitals, Hotels and Clubs which are issued closure directions and intend to either run the unit or remove the plant and machinery to stop/close down the operations. Earlier office order, No. DPCC/CMC-I/Revocation/2017/1323-1333 dated 02nd August 2017, shall cease to be in force with immediate effect in case of Hospitals, Hotels and Clubs. Procedure for other categories shall continue to be as per the earlier order dated 02.8.2017.

- A. After issuance of the directions for closure u/s 31(A) of Air Act, 1981, u/s 33(A) of Water Act, 1974 & u/s 5 of Environment (Protection), Act, 1986, all the consent/authorization and pending applications prior to issuance of the said directions shall be treated as null and void and accordingly letter for refusal/revocation of consent/authorization shall be issued by concerned Cell incharge.
- B. If the unit intends to run the same unit, they have to submit fresh CTE/CTO/Authorization along with 'Environmental Compensation Security (ECS), for an amount equivalent to ten times the fee applicable for one year for Consent to Operate subject to minimum of Rs. 5.00 lacs valid for three years.
- C. On submission of undertaking and ECS, an order would be issued keeping closure directions in abeyance for a period of two months within which the unit shall install requisite pollution control system(s) and submit applications for CTE, CTO and authorization (if applicable) along with all test reports, Adequacy Report(s) of the installed system(s) from the empanelled agency by the Branch/Cell Incharge if the documents submitted by the unit are in order.
- D. Withdrawal of the Directions/ Granting of Consent will be taken as the unit complies with the above conditions. CTE, CTO and authorization will be decided by the respective Authority/Committee as per their competence.
- E. If the unit fails to comply with the above, Environmental Compensation Security would be forfeited and simultaneously prosecution would be launched against the

management of establishment. Closure directions will be reinforced without any further reference to the unit.

This is issued as per the decision taken by the DPCC in its 67th meeting held on 25.10.2018.
