





Minutes of the meeting of the Committee for II(b) Category cases for the Hotel/Guest Houses/ Restaurant of Mahipalpur Area headed by Member Secretary (DPCC) vide office order 12.04.2016 on 07.10.2016 for decided Consent under Air & Water Act

Following officials attended the meeting

- i) Sh. SM Ali, MS DPCC
- ii) Sh. P.S. Pankaj, EE
- iii) Sh. Krishan Kumar, EE


The committee was appraised that DPCC has status of 118 Hotels & Restaurants operating in Mahipalpur and adjoining area which came into focus due to the direction of the Honble NGT. The committee discussed the status after keeping analogous cases in different heads as below.

- 1) The committee agreed with the suggestion as enumerated in (**Annexure -I**) in respect of 11 no. Hotels/Units which have been closed for no action with a caveat that an inspections to these units be conducted with in a month to re-verify the facts
- 2) The committed was informed that 18 No. of the units have already been granted CTE & CTO. Of these 18 units 14 units have fully complied with the Environmental norms, hence no action is proposed. Committee agreed with the suggestion (**Annexure-II-a**), 03 No. of units have not installed ETP/STP. The committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice for revocation of consent these 03 units (**Annexure-II-b**). one of the unit has installed ETP/STP but has not submitted Effluent analysis report, the committee decided that a letter may be issued to the unit for submission of test report within 15 days. (**Annexure -II-c**)
- 3) It was informed to the committee that 50 No. Hotels/ Units have completed their environmental compliances and has submitted all the necessary required documents. The committed decided that CTE & CTO may be granted to these units (**Annexure-III-a & b**)
- 4) It was informed to the committee that 7 No. Hotels/Units have submitted CTE and other required documents. The committee decided that CTE may be granted and a letter may be issued for applying CTO. (**Annexure-IV**)
- 5) The committee was informed that 04 No. units to whom Direction for Closure were issued, have applied for CTE. The committee decided that CTE may be granted and Direction may be revoked temporarily for 45 days to enable the units for applying CTO. (**Annexure-V**)
- 6) The committee approved the issuance of Show cause notice for 09 no. of cases who have not installed ETP/STP (**Annexure-VI**)
- 7) Miscellaneous cases (09 cases)-
 - b) In the miscellaneous 05 No. cases the committee decided as below **Annexure-VII-a**
 - I. **Hotel Swapnil International**- Unit submitted representation that they have closed their Hotel activity, inspection be carried out.
 - II. **Hotel Moti Mahal Deluxe**- La Sapphire has taken the charge of Motimahal Restaurant for which it has obtained CTE and CTO .
 - III. **Hotel Sun View**-Unit has closed, New hotel M/s Anupam Hotel was found operating at the time of inspection (this hotel has applied CTE) Decision already taken in **Annexure-IV**
 - IV. **Hotel Gaurav Continental**- Decision already taken in **Annexure-VII-b**.
 - V. **Hotel RK** -Inspection be conducted.

- b) It was informed to that committee that 05 No. cases have not responded to our Closure Directions, also no ATR received from concern agencies. The committee decided that compliance be sought from the concerned agencies. (**Annexure-VII-b**)
- 8) The committee was informed that List of 09 units, out of 43units, submitted by the association of Mahipalpur Association Hotelier of before Hon'ble NGT in O.A. no.462 of 2015 as complaint 07 units have not complied with the environmental norms, **Annexure-VIII-a**. The committee decided to issue Modified Directions. 02 units have not submitted any compliance, nor replied to our SCN. Committee decided to issued Closure Directions **Annexure-VIII-b**.



