The meeting of the Committee No. 1, constituted for deciding Application for grant of Authorization under the BMW Rules, and consent under Air Act was held on **15.11.2007**. Decisions taken by the Committee are given below:-

I General Decisions Taken:

- (i) The inspection done by PGRC on complaints filed against M/s Panacea Biotech at Mohan Co-operative Industrial Estate and Okhla Industrial Area indicates that these units need to take authorization under BMW Rules for all the three units of M/s Panacea Biotech. In view of the above 3 cases, file along with their applications will be furnished by PGRC Cell to BMW Cell. These cases will be studied for appropriate action during BMW Meeting on 31.12.07.

It has also been reported that M/s Panacea Biotech is sending its toxic wastes / Bio-Medical Waste to M/s Synergy Waste Management Pvt. Ltd. A letter be issued to M/s Synergy Waste Management Pvt. Ltd., how they are treating the toxic wastes / Bio-Medical Waste collected from the said units. They may also be asked to ensure the authorization under BMW Rules from the units from which they are collecting any toxic waste. Regarding the units from which they are collecting BMW Waste, who have not applied for authorization under BMW Rules to DPCC, they will inform DPCC about such units and will also inform DPCC about the nature of waste and handling method. Dr. T.K. Joshi, Head, COEH, Chairman of inspection team has also confirmed and will substantiate with a letter that all drugs manufacturing units operating in NCT of Delhi are covered under BMW Rules and generates BMW. EE(BMW) must contact drug controller of Delhi Government and get a list of all registered drug units in Delhi (Manufacturing, assembling/ packaging, storage, warehouses and R & D Labs). This list should be produced by EE (BMW) in the meeting on 31.12.2007.

- (ii) BMW Committee No. 2 & 3 will hold regular meetings, once in every month to clear the pendency of applications received for authorization under BMW Rules & Consent under the Air Act.
- (iii) Policy Decisions, if required, shall be taken with the approval of the Chairman, DPCC / BMW Committee No.1.
