

Minutes of the MSW Committee meeting held on 21-2-2007

A meeting of MSW committee was held on 21-2-2007 in the office of the Chairman, Delhi Pollution Control Committee. The following officials attended the said meeting :

The committee considered three applications and technical details as per agenda. The following is the summary of the decisions :

- a. The committee decided to with hold the permission for Integrated Municipal Waste Complex at Okhla sanitary landfill site till the clearance from remaining agencies are received by DPCC. Other details are mentioned in the enclosed minutes of the meeting.
- b. The committee decided to grant the authorization under MSW Rules for setting up an integrated municipal waste complex at Timarpur Incineration Plant Site to MCD subject to the addendum in the conditions in the consent to establish under Air and Water Act that an on-line emission monitoring device will be provided at the stack.
- c. The committee decided to grant the authorization under MSW Rules for setting up an integrated municipal waste complex at NDMC Compost Plant Site at Sukhdev Vihar, Okhla. Other details are mentioned in the enclosed minutes of the meeting.

Sanitary Landfill Site

1. Name of the agency ---- Municipal Corporation of Delhi
2. Particular of the project ----

Setting up of integrated municipal waste complex at Okhla Sanitary Land fill Site. The capacity of the project would be 600TPD MSW, beside 100 MGD liquid waste. The treatment / processing of the MSW would be based on DST-TIFAC technology of mixed MW to Rdf /Fluff preparation and bio gas generation from the organic waste. The power generation would be 3.75 MW. Cost of project is Rs 400 mn.
3. Date of Authorization ---- 22-07-2005
4. Clearance from other department ----

 - c. Delhi Development Authority:- NOC not received however earlier a letter was received stating that the land is used by MCD without allotment by DDA and further submitted that the view needs to be taken regarding its development only after examining the projects in the surrounding areas.

 - e. The Commanding Officer, NOC Division, Air Force HQ, Delhi:- NOC not received

 - b. As per Hon'ble S.C. order dated 6-5-5, the central government would not sanction any further subsidies to Municipal solid waste treatment plants in view of the report that generation of electricity was dipped near 0.3 MW to 0.5 MW against the projected 5 MW.

B. Timarpur Incineration Plant Site

1. Name of the agency ---- Municipal Corporation of Delhi
2. Particular of the project ----

Setting up of integrated municipal waste complex at Timarpur Incineration Plant Site. The capacity of the project would be 600TPD MSW, beside 100 MGD liquid waste. The treatment / processing of the MSW would be based on DST-TIFAC technology of mixed MW to Rdf /Fluff preparation and bio gas generation from the organic waste. The power generation would be 3.75 MW. Cost of project is Rs 400 mn.
3. Date of Authorization ---- 22-07-2005
4. Clearance from other department ----

C. NDMC Compost Plant Site

1. Name of the agency ---- New Delhi Municipal Council

2. Particular of the project ----

Setting up of integrated municipal waste complex at NDMC Compost Plant site at Sukhdev Vihar, Okhla. The capacity of the project would be 950 TPD MSW, beside 150 TPD green garbage. The treatment / processing of the MSW would be based on DST-TIFAC technology of mixed MW to Rdf /Fluff preparation and bio gas generation from the organic waste. The power generation would be 10 MW. Cost of project is Rs 700 mn.
