Minutes of the 27th Meeting of the Committee for II(b) Category Cases
held on 13.03.2020 and 14.03.2020

Attendance Sheets for meeting on 13.03.2020 and 14.03.2020 are enclosed as Annexure "A" & "B".
Following are the Minutes of the Meetings:-

**Agenda Item No 1: All Pending cases of Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate /
Renewal upto 10.03.2020.**

The cases of this agenda were decided online. During the meeting, it was observed that some of the cases were not reflected in the agenda. Therefore, committee decided to take up these cases in next CMC meeting along with the remaining cases.

Decisions taken, w.r.t. applications for Consent to Establish dated 28.01.2020 and Consent to Operate dated 06.02.2020 of M/s Indi Colour Prints, A-65, Naraina Industrial Area, Phase-I, New Delhi-110028 for the activity of Printing without Trade Effluent Discharge, be ratified.

Apart from the above, it was also apprised to the committee that a number of requests in respect of water effluent / emission monitoring are lying pending in Laboratory, DPCC and the said matter was also taken by the committee for II(a) category cases and during the meeting dated 02.01.2020, it was decided that all the requests for emissions and water monitoring should be considered within 01 month without fail. It was decided that if the in-house testing facilities are not streamlined within one month, units may be asked to get the monitoring report(s) from the NABL accredited laboratory for appropriate decision by DPCC.

In view of above, chairman of the committee has decided that monitoring report(s) from the NABL accredited laboratory will also be considered for deciding the consent applications till further orders.

During the meeting, following decisions were taken:-

- (i) Chairman of the Committee has decided that for the cases who have applied for Consent to Establish/Operate/Renewal on MHA portal, and found the application complete in all respect, Consent to Establish/Operate/Renewal be granted. Further, in case of incomplete documents, unit be asked to submit the requisite documents within 7 days and if unit submits the same and found satisfactory, Consent to Establish/Operate/Renewal be granted. In case, unit fails to submit the same, Consent to Establish/Operate/Renewal be refused without any further approval. This decision be followed in all such cases in future.

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
- (ii) It was observed during the meeting that some of the cases were considered for grant of consent to operate in which directions for closure were also issued and decisions in respect of revocation of closure directions shall be taken as per office order dated 02.08.2017.
- (iii) It was observed that there is ambiguity to obtain MCD/Delhi Police/Fire licenses for considering the cases fall under RESDH Sector. To maintain the uniformity, Chairman of the Committee has decided to grant consent to establish and consent to operate and renewal without obtaining MCD/Delhi Police/Fire licenses however the consent to operate will be granted with the condition that unit shall submit valid MCD/Delhi Police/Fire licenses within 03 months from the date of issuance of consent. In case, unit fails to submit the same, consent to operate will be revoked automatically.
- (iv) It was decided by the Committee that in case of incomplete application, concerned Cell shall raise a clarification to the unit giving 07 days time and if unit has failed to submit / upload its reply in response to clarification raised by DPCC within stipulated period. Incharge of concerned cell shall issue show cause notice for refusal of consent immediately by giving 15 days time without prior permission of the committee.
- (v) It was observed that there was no provision in the new online software of DPCC developed by NIC to take print out the agenda and minutes of the meeting. IT Cell was directed to make a provision to obtain print out the agenda and minutes of the Committee. It was also observed that new online software developed by NIC is lacking in respect of many fields and thus many difficulties are being faced by CMC officials in deciding the cases and the same were apprised to the representative of NIC during meeting and asked to rectify on urgent basis. IT Cell to take up the matter on priority.
- (vi) It was observed that in most of the cases, checklist was not prepared properly and concerned Cell did not provide its recommendations. Hence, it was directed by Chairman of the Committee that the concerned Cell will prepare checklist and give proper recommendations.
- (vii) All CMCs are directed to check each and every documents including required consent fee before issuing the consent to establish and consent to operate.

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(viii) All CMCs are directed to comply with the decisions of the committee within 07 days from the date of issue of these minutes and submit a compliance report to MS, DPCC through Incharge, CMC-V positively.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
