Office Order

For smooth functioning of DPCC, in partial modification of the office Order of even number dated 06.03.2012, the para 9 and 10 of the said office order are hereby amended and para 11 is inserted as follows:

1. The prevailing practice of revoking the closure directions on the furnishing the affidavit and the bank gurantees under Water Act or/and Air Act or/and Hazardous Rules shall be discontinued forthwith. Defaulting units shall first be made to comply with pollution control norms and then only revocation direction be issued. Once required pollution control equipment are installed or a firm undertaking for time bound installation of pollution control equipments/rectification of deficiencies is submitted, temporary conditional revocation for a period of only 45 days may be issued for the purpose of installation/ testing equipments. No commercial production shall be allowed during this period. The final revocation direction shall be issued only after the submission of satisfactory adequacy Reports/test report.

The Temporary revocation shall be issued subject to following terms:

- (i) The units whose activity are not covered under SPI/GPI, they have to file surety bond of Rs. 2 Lacs for the small units, whose total investment is less then Rs. 50 lacs and Rs. 5 Lacs for the units whose total investment is more than Rs. 50 lacs.
- (ii) The units whose activity are covered under SPI/GPI, they have to file surety bond of Rs. 5 Lacs for the small units, whose total investment is less then Rs. 50 lacs and Rs. 10 Lacs for the units whose total investment is more than Rs. 50 lacs.
- (iii) In case of Clubs/restaurants/Hotel etc. following surety bond is applicable;
  - Area for unit operation upto 1000 SQM- Rs. I lakhs
  - Area for unit operation more then 1000 SQM but upto I acre Rs. 10 lakhs
  - Area for unit operation more than 1 acre Rs. 20 lakhs

This is not applicable for star category Hotels.

- (iv) In case of Star category Hotels, following surety bond is applicable;
  - 2 star Hotel Rs. 10 lakhs
  - 3 & 4 star Hotel Rs. 20 lakhs
  - 5 star Hotel Rs. 30 lakhs

On the time of issuance of revocation of direction unit has to file undertaking giving the details of electric connection number with meter reading on the date of undertaking/ details of water supply connection number with meter reading on the date of undertaking as well as undertaking with the effect that they will not use DG sets and borewells for commercial use.

- 10. In case of extreme exceptional urgencies or in public interest temporary revocation direction may be considered for a unit on submission of a bank gurantee for an amount 10 times the annual fee for consent to operate subject to minimum of Rs. 5 lacs as a deterrent. Such temporary revocation shall for a period of 3 months only. The final revocation direction shall however be issued only after the submission of satisfactory Adequacy Report/ test report. This para is not applicable for the industries, whose activity falls under the list of SPI/GPI.
