Meeting of the Committee No. 3, constituted for deciding application for authorization under BMW Rules and Consent under Air Act was held on 28.11.2007, in the Chamber of SEE (BMW) and Action Taken Report of earlier meetings held & 100 cases of the Hospitals / Health Care Establishments having 9 beds and below were placed before the Committee.

Following are the decisions taken by the Committee;

1. The Committee perused the minutes and ATRs of its earlier meetings held on 01.05.07, 09.08.07, 17.08.07, 20.09.07 & 18.10.07. Authorizations under BMW Rules were issued and letters were also issued seeking consent Application under Air Act. In most of the cases, consent application under Air Act / Affidavit regarding not having DG set, were not received. In these cases a reminder letter may be issued to such Health Care Units. The units which have informed regarding not having DG Set and also submitted an affidavit in this regard, a certain percentage (10%) of the cases may be inspected to verify the claim as per the approval of Chairman, DPCC.
2. The Committee considered the representation received from M/s Samadhan Diagnostic Clinic, 81-A, Kamala Nagar, Delhi-07, in respect of the balance fees (extra fee for the extra period) charged by DPCC .The Committee recommended that the issue be submitted to Member Secretary / Chairman, DPCC, in view of the different procedure being followed by Consent Management Cell, for taking an appropriate decision. The fresh authorization in fresh cases decided by the Committee in this meeting may be issued after the decision by Chairman on the issue of balance fee.
3. Inspections as per the decision of the Committee-3 in its earlier meetings were to be carried out in 35 No. of cases. However inspections could be carried in 10 cases and the same were placed before the Committee. Inspections could not be carried out in 25 cases due to non availability of official Vehicle. Member Secretary may be requested to provide the separate vehicle to BMW Cell to avoid such delays . 10 cases of inspections were discussed & decisions taken in these cases are given at **Annexure-I.**
4. The Committee found that in 09 cases the Health Care Units have reported closure of their units/ letters demanding balance fee have returned back undelivered. The Committee recommended inspections of these 09 cases by a team of DPCC Officers. List of such units is at **Annexure II**
5. 100 cases of the Hospitals / Health Care Establishments having 9 beds and below were placed before the Committee and decision taken is given at **Annexure III.**



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
