**OFFICE ORDER**

The term of the committee will be for 6 months with effect from date of issue of this order.

**Terms of Reference for committee:**

1. Compliance with the LAEC directions dated 3/04/06 regarding giving incentive to the industrial units in the form of award to the meritorious units for safe handling, storage and disposal of hazardous waste in line with Hazardous Waste Rules, 1989.
2. The Committee will chalk out the methodology for deciding upon the worthy industrial unit for conferring the award.

3. Should a need arise, carry out or cause to carry out environmental audit for the purpose.
4. May interact with DPCC/ industrial associations and seek their co-operation in effectively carrying out its function.

**Rules of Business for the committee**

1. The committee shall observe/consider the basic principles of natural justice, transparency, relevant scientific data and various pollution prevention and control measures before arriving at its findings/ conclusions.
2. The committee shall be assisted by the DPCC to procure from any employer/establishment/competent officer therein such information or access to samples for analysis as may be required by it for performing its functions.
3. The committee wishing to observe hazardous wastes handling practice in any of the industrial units may do so only through the DPCC for facilitation. The committee members should observe the relevant safety practices while inside the industrial premises.
4. All the expenses of the members of the committee (including travel of its members) will be met by the Delhi Pollution Control Committee.
5. Copies of consents and authorization issued to the units in the subject area as well as a complete list of authorized industries of the area shall be provided to the committee by DPCC.
6. Primary contact point for the Chairman of the Committee is the Member Secretary, DPCC for implementation of Terms of Reference.

The committee member fixed the following criteria for selection of meritorious unit for this award:

- a. Those units will be considered which have valid consent under Air Act and Water Act and Authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules.
- b. Only those units will be considered which apply for this award.
- c. As discussed in previous meeting, for wide publicity of this award, an advertisement will be published in leading news papers. The copy of the published notice shall also be circulated to Industrial Associations and CETPs Societies. In addition to this, letters will also be issued to all the units of the said categories which have valid consent under Air and Water Act and Authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management & Handling) Rules.
- d. Those units which apply for award to DPCC, a special inspection team shall be constituted by Consent Management Committee (Orange) of DPCC for the inspection of such units.
- e. This special inspection team will make the general inspection and specifically look for the following points:
  - i) Efforts made for waste minimization.
  - ii) Waste Storage vis a vis estimated waste generation.
  - iii) General house keeping and storage conditions.
  - iv) Hazardous Waste minimization practices.
  - v) Assessment of previous records available in DPCC in support of compliance for last five years.
  - vi) Record maintenance in respect of chemical used for treatment of effluents.
  - vii) Adoption of any clean process technology.

Further, based upon the inspection report of the Special Inspection Team and previous records, the committee will shortlist three units in each category and recommend these to Consent Management Committee (Orange) of DPCC for further consideration of the award. The format for the public notice and the application form were also finalized.

The committee was informed about the Public Notice issued on 08.03.08 wherein concerned units were requested to submit the information for award of meritorious units for safe management of Hazardous Waste. Apart from this all CETPs Societies and Industrial Association as well as eligible Industrial Units were also requested to submit the applications. In the response of the public notice the following three applications were received:

As only three applications were received for the award hence, the committee recommended that all three applications shall be considered for the award including those application received just after due date and forwarded to Consent Management Committee (Orange) for inspection by a special inspection team to be constituted by Consent Management Committee (Orange).

The Committee also made preliminary evaluation of these three units in the form of comparative chart enclosed herewith. The comparative chart also includes the inspection report for last five years. The Committee also observed that United Engineers Service Station, Opp. Nehru Place Bus Terminal, New Delhi-110019 is servicing 10-12 cars per day and the approximate quantity of hazardous waste generation mentioned as “5-6 lit/ month waste oil & 20-25 Kg/ month ETP sludge”, which appears to be in very lower side. Hence, the committee is of the view that application of M/s. United Engineers Service Station may be rejected provided Consent Management Committee (Orange) agrees with this observation.

The committee also proposed that the tenure of the committee may be extended up to 31.05.08 which was expired on 27.03.08.
