Security Bond

IS/o.....R/o.....running a unit the name and style M/s.....at.....as its sole proprietor/partner/director, do hereby execute a Security Bond in favour of Delhi Pollution Control Committee for a sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) or Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) (as applicable) on the term and conditions as set out hereinafter.

Whereas DPCC has issued closure direction to my unit as named above for violations of Water Act, 1974 and Provisions / Rules under Environment Protection Act, 1986 on_____.

And whereas my unit as named above has applied for Consent to Operate on.....and requested for revocation of the closure direction of DPCC.

Now, the undersigned is furnishing the present Security Bond to be forfeited in case of non-compliance of directions issued by DPCC / conditions imposed in consent granted by DPCC or in material default of compliance of Water Act, 1974 / Air Act, 1981/ HW(MHTM) Rules, 2008 and relevant Environmental laws / in case of violation of undertaking given by the unit.

I, the undersigned unequivocally undertake to abide by the all pollution control norms as are applicable to my unit and undertake as follows:-

- (I) That ETP shall be used only for the purpose of treating the effluent discharged from the rinsed water tank and rinsing washing area used by the unit. Neither acid residue (HW Cat. 12.1) nor spent bath sludge (HW Cat. 12.3) shall be diverted to ETP.
- (II) That unit shall not handle acid residue (HW Cat. 12.1), spent bath sludge (HW Cat. 12.3) and ETP sludge (HW Cat. 34.3) in any other manner except storing the same as hazardous wastes and maintain the records of such storage .
- (III) That unit will reuse the acid(s) to the maximum extent to reduce the quantity of waste acid by modifying the in-house practices.
- (IV) That unit shall discharge its treated effluent into the conveyance system attached to CETP. The unit shall be jointly and severally be responsible for proper operation of CETP as per prescribed norms. In case CETP does not function as per prescribed norms, the unit shall be liable to be closed, in other words the unit shall be closed not only for its failure in adhering to the prescribed norms and directions of DPCC/law but also for non-functioning of CETP as per prescribed norms and non-compliance of directions of DPCC/law by the CETP society.
- (V) That average generation of acid residue/ spent acid is Litres in 15 days.
- (VI) The unit shall be closed on or before 22.09.2016.
- (VII) That the Bank Guarantee of remaining amount of Rs 3 Lakh or 6 Lakh (as applicable) will be submitted within period of 3 month of issuance of the Bank Guarantee already submitted.
- (VIII) That spent acid / acid residue being the hazardous waste in liquid / semi liquid form, appropriate containment system as follows will be provided before commissioning the storage:-

- i. The container in containment system will be secure enough to prevent leaks & spills and corrosion (having capacity less than 200 litres) with proper labelling in vernacular language and specifically mentioning the name of the unit date of storage of hazardous waste with waste category and quantity.
- ii. The containments system will have an underlying base free from cracks and sufficiently impervious to contain leachate, any leaks spill etc.
- iii. The containment system will be provided which will be able to drain and remove liquids which may result from leak, spill or precipitation.
- iv. The containment system will have sufficient capacity to contain 10 % of the volume of containers or the largest container, whichever is higher.
- v. Run-on into the containment system will be prevented unless the collection system has sufficient excess capacity in addition to that mentioned in paragraph (iii) of to contain any run-on which might enter the system.
- vi. The containment system will have sump or collection area to collect any leak, spill or precipitation. Spill or leaked waste and accumulated precipitation should be removed from the sump or collection area in as timely a manner as is necessary to prevent over flow of the collection system.
- vii. Hazardous waste will not be placed in tanks for storage/treatment.

I further undertake that in case of non-compliance of directions issued by DPCC / conditions imposed in consent granted by DPCC or in material default of compliance of Water Act, 1974 / Air Act, 1981/ HW(MHTM) Rules, 2008 and relevant Environmental laws including violation of undertakings given by the unit, I undertake to pay to the Delhi Pollution Control Committee a sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) or Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) (as applicable) without demur and default.

I further undertake that the present security bond remain valid from the date of its execution till date of submission of the remaining balance Bank Guarantee of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Only) or Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs Only) (as applicable) .
